have vision loss as they don't have access to eye care services

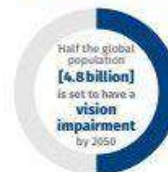


Vision loss

Unless there is a **significant investment**, eye care services are unlikely to cope with future needs.

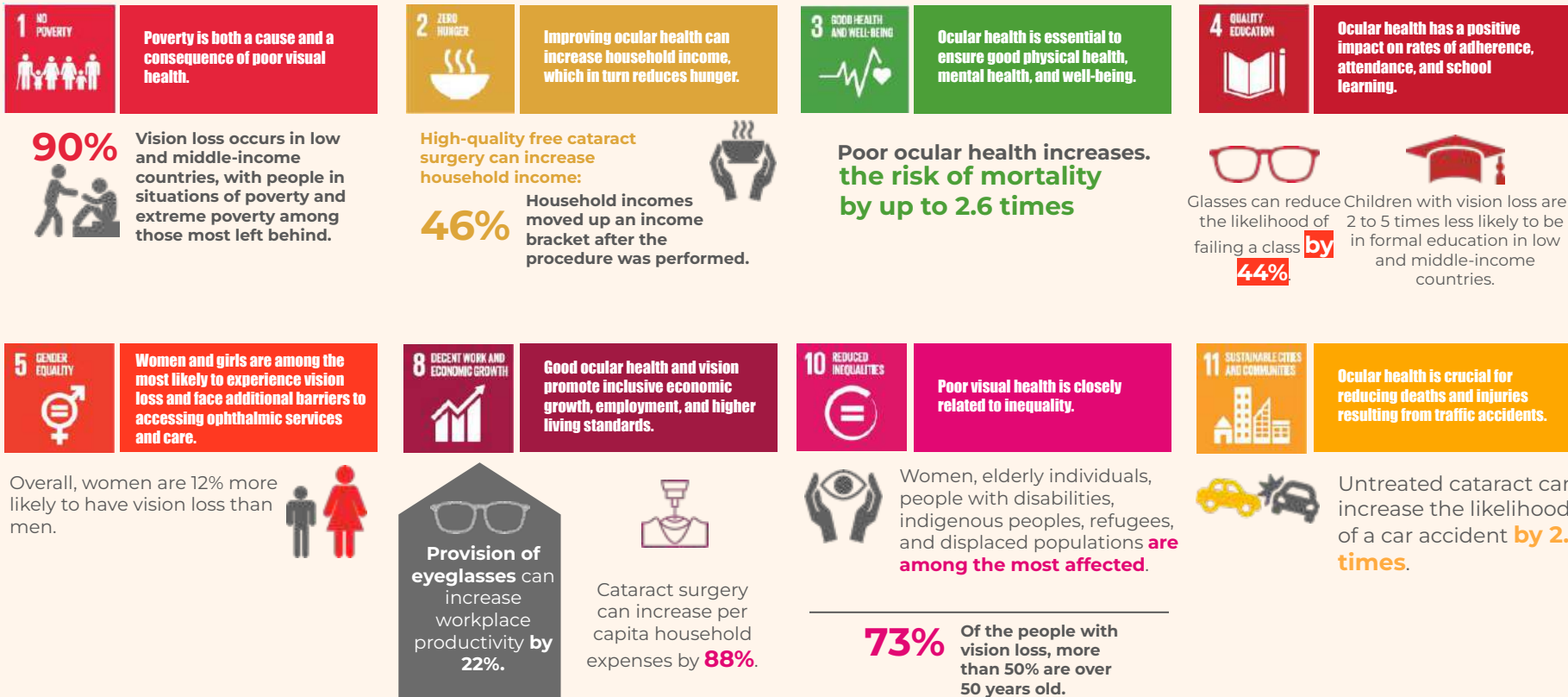

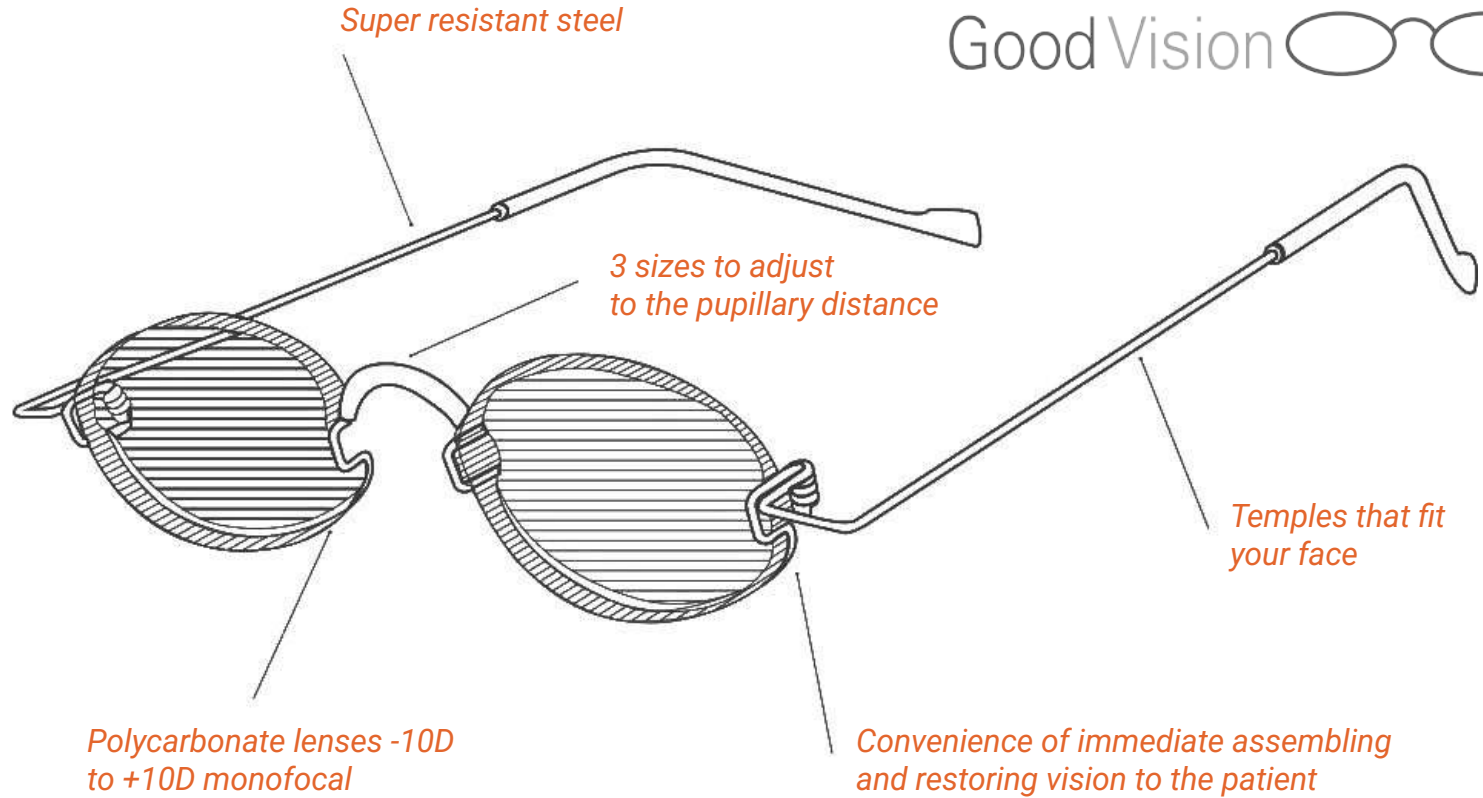
of visual impairment among indigenous populations can be solved by spectacles

Those who require single-vision monofocal spectacles (-7 to +7 diopters) receive them immediately after the consultation.

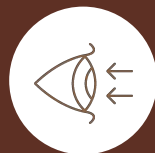
For multifocal spectacles: delivered within up to 60 days

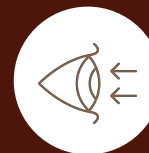
